Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Harbans Singh, Police Station Singh Bhagwant Pura, Roopnagar, submits that as a matter of fact, alleged detainee Harinder Singh, who was in Punjab Police as Constable, however claimed as ASI by learned counsel for the petitioner, has been found involved in four FIRs. He was arrested in FIR No.136 dated 19.12.2014 under Sections 399/402 IPC, Police Station Singh Bhagwant Pura, District Roopnagar and was presented before the learned Court of competent jurisdiction very next day. She further submits that in this view of the matter, present petition has been rendered infructuous and the same may be disposed of, as such.

The abovesaid statement made by learned counsel for the State has not been contested by learned counsel for the petitioner and rightly so

because it being a matter of record. He fairly states that let the present petition be disposed of in view of the statement made by learned counsel for the State.
