Learned senior counsel for the petitioner prays that he be permitted to withdraw the instant petition so as to pursue the appeal (Annexure P4), the petitioner had preferred against the order of his dismissal dated 25.10.2007 (Annexure P3) before respondent No.1. However, he contends that respondent No.1 be directed to decide the same within a stipulated period of time.
