The petitioner has invoked the inherent jurisdiction of this Court under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, for issuance of directions to respondents to release the petitioner on emergency parole for four weeks, for treatment of his father who is suffering from Degenerative Arthritis R Hip and the doctor advised for total hip replacement.
