The instant petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India was filed for issuance of a writ in the nature of habeas corpus directing respondents No.1 to 5 to get released detainees namely Gorakh Singh and Samandeep Singh stated to be in illegal custody of respondents No.6 to 8.

Report of the Warrant Officer has been received. As per report both the alleged detainees Gorakh Singh and Samandeep Singh, who were standing before the sub office of the Raman Truck Union alongwith both the trucks were handed over to the petitioner. Both the alleged detainees were found roaming freely and were not found in illegal custody of respondents No.6 to 8.

Accordingly, no further action is required and the present petition has become infructuous and is disposed of as such.
