Petitioner – Santosh alleged that her son was kept in illegal confinement on false allegations of possessing a knife. Two police officials, namely, Partap Singh and Devender Singh had arrested him and demanded Rs.20,000/- for release of detainee, Peeru alias Sanjay. One lady police official, namely, Anju of Patran Police Station was also named stating that the police concerned had also registered a false case of abduction “with” Anju. This allegation is quite vague.

In the reply filed on behalf of the State of Punjab by way of affidavit of DSP Patran, namely, Swaranjit Singh, no police official by the name of Anju was posted there. The allegations were false and it was stated that son of the petitioner was never booked before.

Reply on behalf of State of Haryana filed today is taken on record. It is submitted that son of the petitioner was arrested as two different cases are pending against him. One case is FIR No.976 dated 13.12.2008 of Police Station City Panipat under the Arms Act and the other one is FIR No.1602 dated 14.12.2014 under Section 174-A IPC of the same

Police Station. In the first case, the son of the petitioner, i.e. Peeru alias

Sanjay is stated to be proclaimed offender.

In view of the reply submitted as above, the petition is dismissed.
