DAYA CHAUDHARY, J.

An application dated 31.07.2015 was sent by Manpreet Kaur w/o Harbhagwant Singh @ Harji to Hon'ble the Chief Justice of this Court which was treated as criminal writ petition on judicial side.

Notice of motion was issued on 07.08.2015 and in response thereto, reply by way of an affidavit of Deputy Superintendent of Police(Investigation), District Tarn Taran has been filed in the Court today and the same is taken on record.

Learned State counsel, on the basis of reply, submits that the petitioner has levelled false allegations against the local police whereas two cases i.e. FIR No.170 dated 28.09.2012 registered under Sections 21/61/85 of NDPS Act and Section 5 of Official Secrets Act, 1923 at Police Station

Bhikhiwind, District Tarn Taran and FIR No.117 dated 17.08.2015 registered under Sections 21/29/25/61/85 of NDPS Act at Police Station Harike, District Tarn Taran, are pending against the present petitioner. Learned State counsel also submits that FIR No.170 dated 28.09.2012 is pending for investigation with the CBI in compliance of order dated 03.09.2013 passed by this Court in Criminal Misc. No.M-20003 of 2013. Learned State counsel also submits that the husband of the petitioner is also in custody in aforesaid FIR No.117.

In view of stand taken in the reply, there is no merit in the present petition and the same being devoid of any merit is hereby dismissed.
