Report dated 10.08.2015 of the warrant officer has been received and the same is already on record.

Learned state counsel submits that the petitioner is also involved in FIR No.118 dated 04.08.2015 registered under Sections 148, 149, 323, 324, 341 and 506 IPC, wherein he is on bail.

As per the aforesaid report, on reaching the police station, the warrant officer inquired ASI Baksa Singh with regard to the custody of Dharampal son of Hawa Singh, Sonu son of Surajmal, Parveen son of Dharma, Pardeep son of Ram Dia and Anil son of Bhim Singh after which ASI Baksa Singh informed that no such persons were in their custody. At that point of time, Vicky, relative of the petitioner informed that all the above said persons were sitting near the entrance gate. The warrant officer was informed by ASI Baksa Singh that the said persons along with Dilbagh

Singh, Chairman, Panchayat Block Samiti, Rajound reached the police station just 5 minutes before the arrival of the warrant officer. To verify this fact, the warrant officer made an inquiry from the Sentry and he also informed that these persons had reached there just 4 to 5 minutes before, along with the Chairman. While the proceedings were going on, all the above said persons along with the Chairman left the police station.

Keeping in view the report of the warrant officer and the assertion raised by the complainant, it does not appear to be illconceived

Dismissed.
