This petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India read with Section 482 Cr.P.C. for grant of emergency parole to the petitioner as the marriage of the petitioner's son namely Harchand Singh is fixed for 23.08.2015.

Short affidavit of Hardev Singh, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division, Zira, District Ferozepur, filed in the Court, is taken on record.

As per the affidavit, marriage of Harchand Singh son of the petitioner is fixed for 23.08.2015.

The learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner had earlier availed parole on various occasions and he never misused the concession of parole, which fact is not controverted by the learned State counsel.

Heard.

Considering the fact that the marriage of the son of the petitioner is fixed for 23.08.2015 and being a father he has to arrange the marriage ceremony on behalf of parental side, the petitioner is ordered to be released on parole, for a period of three weeks from the date of his release, as per the Rules, on furnishing bonds to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Karnal.

The petitioner shall surrender before the jail authorities after expiry of three weeks, on the date and time to be indicated by the releasing authority at the time of his release.

Disposed of.
