Prayer made in the petition filed under Article 226 read with Article 20 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of writ, order or direction to the Superintendent, District Jail, Yamuna Nagar to allow emergency parole to the petitioner, so as to enable him to get his father treated.

According to the petitioner, his father who is chronic patient of liver disease, has been referred by Dr. G. Rehman of Seth Baldev Dass District Hospital, Sharanpur to higher centre for further management and admission for surgery. In this regard the petitioner has placed on record copy of the medical certificate (Annexure P-1).

According to the petitioner, his application for release on emergency parole is not being entertained by the Superintendent, District Jail, Yamuna Nagar on the ground that the petitioner is a hardcore prisoner.

Mr. Praveen Bhadu, Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents. A copy of the petition along with its Annexures has been supplied by learned counsel for the petitioner to the learned State Counsel in the Court itself.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties, the instant petition is disposed of with a direction to the Superintendent, District Jail, Yamuna Nagar, Haryana to entertain the application of the petitioner for release on emergency parole and take final decision on the same in accordance with law, but within a period of three weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.
