Harjinder Kaur has come present in the Court and has been identified by Mr. Vivek K. Thakur, Advocate. She has made a statement before this Court that she has undergone marriage with Jaswant Singh petitioner and presently residing with him and wants to stay with him and does not want to accompany her mother Satnam

Kaur respondent No.4, who has come present in Court and has been identified by Mr. Rakesh Kumar, Advocate.

Faced with this situation, learned counsel for the petitioner has made a statement before this Court withdrawing the present petition.

Allowed to do so.

The petition stands dismissed as withdrawn.

However, it is made clear that the mother respondent No.4 is well within her rights to invoke jurisdiction of the appropriate forum regarding the legality and validity of the marriage and the factum of guardianship of the girl, whom she claims is a minor.
