Short affidavit dated 11.02.2015 of Sh. Arshadeep Singh Thind, IAS, District Magistrate, Sangrur has been filed pursuant to order dated 28.01.2015, which reads as under:-

- “1. That the SDM Sangrur visited the spot on 11.02.2015 deputed by the deponent vide Letter No. 585/CEA dated 10.02.2015 (Annexure R-1).
2. That the SDM Sangrur has reported the matter vide enquiry report dated 10.02.2015 (Annexure R-2) that none of the alleged detaining member in the list were found at the brick kiln. The copies of the statements of Sushil Kumar Owner of the Brick Kiln and Ashok Kumar Jamadar recorded during the enquiry/visit (Annexures R-3 and R-4) are attached herewith.
3. That from the facts and circumstance emerged out during enquiry, none of the person mentioned in

the writ petition from Sr. No. 1 to Sr. No. 20 was found to have ever come at the said Brick kiln, so question of detaining them illegally and unlawfully does not arise.

It is, therefore, respectfully prayed that in view of the submissions made above, the present petition may kindly be dismissed.”

Keeping in view the fact that this petition has been received through post and there is none to controvert the averments made in report, no further orders are called for at this stage.

Copy of this order as well as reply filed on behalf of the State be communicated to the petitioner at the given address. Liberty is afforded to the petitioners to move an appropriate application in case any of the averments in the reply are found to be incorrect.

Present petition is, accordingly, disposed of.
