1. The Registering Officer is directed to register the marriage of the petitioners in accordance with law on production of proof of marriage on the day when they state that the marriage took place. The petitioners' stand for the bondage of marriage is after they are majors and, therefore, the avoidability of the marriage solemnized during their minority cannot any longer affect the validity. If the petitioners show proof of the solemnization of the marriage in the manner required, the Registering Officer shall register the marriage.

2. The counsel for the petitioners states that the 1<sup>st</sup> petitioner has arrived in India and he is present. The registration shall be done on production of this order.

3. The writ petition is disposed of as above.
