The application sent by Simarjit Kaur to the office of Hon'ble the Acting Chief Justice is treated as criminal writ petition and is taken up on judicial side.

Notice of motion was issued to respondent-State.

Learned State counsel appeared. Learned State counsel was directed to get conducted the preliminary inquiry and submit the status report.

Today, status/report by way of affidavit of Bhagwant Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division, Jandiala Guru, District Amritsar (Rural) on behalf of State has been filed. Same is taken on record.

As per the said report, police of Special Cell (SB) Delhi arrested Palwinder Singh, husband of petitioner, on 28.08.2015; effected the recovery of 7.560 grams opium from his possession and registered a case FIR No.0050 dated 28.08.2015, under Section 18 of the Narcotic Drugs & Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 in Police Station Special Cell (SB), Delhi against him. Copy of the FIR (Annexure R-1) is also enclosed with the said reply.

Keeping in view the said reply, filed by learned State counsel, no further action is required in this case.

Therefore, the instant petition stands disposed of.
