The present petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of habeas corpus for release of detainee, namely, Reena who is stated to be wife of the petitioner and is in illegal custody of respondents No.4 and 5.

While issuing notice of motion on 04.09.2015, Respondent No.3 was directed to ensure the presence of alleged detainee, namely, Reena in the Court.

In compliance thereto, the alleged detainee, namely, Reena has been produced in the Court who submits that she is residing with her parents as per her free will and she is not under pressure of any sort.

Learned State counsel has filed reply by way of an affidavit of Deputy Superintendent of Police, Yamuna Nagar in the Court today and the same is taken on record.

Keeping in view the submissions made by the alleged detainee, namely, Reena, nothing survives in the present petition and the same being devoid of any merit is hereby dismissed.
