Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Gurcharanjit Singh, Police Station Sadar Ferozepur, submits that alleged detainee was never arrested by the police of Police Station Sadar Ferozepur, as has been wrongly alleged by the applicant-petitioner. She further submits that for the time being, alleged detainee is not required in any fresh criminal case. Although one FIR No.253 dated 02.10.2013 under Sections 18, 21, 61, 85 of NDPS Act and Section 25 of Arms Act is registered at Police Station Sadar Ferozepur and alleged detainee is yet to be arrested in the said FIR. On further instructions, she submits that except this abovesaid FIR, there is no other FIR against the alleged detainee as on date. She prays for disposal of the present petition, as having been rendered infructuous.

In view of the abovesaid statement made by learned counsel for the State, present petition does not survive and the same is ordered to be disposed of, as having been rendered infructuous.
