This Criminal Writ Petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of direction to the respondent No.1 to dispose of premature release case of the petitioner.

The learned counsel contends that on 14.06.2014, after recommendation, respondent No.2, Director General of Police (Jails), Punjab, forwarded the case of the petitioner for premature release to respondent No.1. However, respondent No.1 has not taken any decision on the same.

The learned counsel further submits that at this stage he would be satisfied in case direction is issued to respondent No.1 to consider and decide the premature release case of the petitioner.

Without adverting to the merits of the case, at this stage, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.1, to consider and decide the case of the petitioner for premature release, by passing a speaking order, expeditiously, preferably within a period of four weeks, in accordance with law, from the receipt of certified copy of this order.
