A written request was sent to Hon'ble the Acting Chief Justice of this Court, which was treated as Criminal Writ Petition on judicial side.

As per allegations in the complaint made by petitioner-Rajesh Sharma, Kanwalpreet Kaur told him that her parents and elder sister have given beatings to her many times and she requested him to save her from her parents.

Notice of motion was issued in the case on 6.10.2015.

In response thereto, reply by way of an affidavit of Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Banga, District SBS Nagar has been filed in the Court today and the same is taken on record.

Learned counsel for the respondent-State on the basis of reply and the statement made by Kanwalpreet Kaur submits that she has specifically stated that she never called the petitioner and requested him to

save her from her parents or elder sister. Said Kanwalpreet Kaur has also denied the allegations levelled in the petition.

In view of the statement made by Kanwalpreet Kaur, no ground is made out to interfere in the matter and the present petition being devoid of any merit is hereby dismissed.
