The criminal writ petition has been filed for directing respondents No.1, 3 and 4 to consider the request of the petitioner made on 02.08.2015, for grant of parole for four weeks to him, in terms of Section 3(1) (d) of the Punjab Good Conduct Prisoners (Temporary Release) Act, 1962.

Notice of motion was issued on 14.10.2015. The case was then taken up on 04.11.2015 and adjourned for today.

Ms. Aashima Mor, Advocate, appearing for respondents No.1 and 2 submits that necessary report from the District Magistrate, Jalandhar (respondent No.3) has been received by the Chandigarh Administration and that the same shall be considered and appropriate orders passed on the request of the petitioner for grant of parole for four weeks.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that there is a

marriage in the family of the petitioner on 28.11.2015. Therefore, the orders may be directed to be passed before the said date.

Accordingly, the criminal writ petition is disposed of. The competent authority shall pass the appropriate orders on the request of the petitioner for grant of four weeks parole as soon as possible and preferably by 25.11.2015.
