Prayer made in the petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of appropriate writ, order or direction to the respondents to release the petitioner on furlough.

As per the warrant dated 15.05.2015 (Annexure P-1) already issued by the Commissioner, Rohtak Division, Rohtak, the petitioner was ordered to be released on furlough for a period

of three weeks, subject to certain conditions including requiring him to furnish bonds and two sureties in the amount of ₹ 2 lacs each. According to the petitioner, the amount of bonds specified by the Commissioner was too high and it be reduced. Further, the petitioner expressed apprehension that his opposite party in the village might oppose his temporary release.

Reply has been filed by way of an affidavit of the Superintendent, District Jail, Sonapat on behalf of the respondents wherein it has been mentioned that the Commissioner, Rohtak Division, Rohtak has already reduced the surety amount to Rs.1,00,000/- and the District Magistrate, Sonapat directed to give effect to the warrant of the release dated 15.05.2015. It has also been stated that the relief of furlough granted to the petitioner cannot be withdrawn merely on the complaint of the opposite party.

Once the authorities have reduced the surety amount from ₹ 2,00,000/- to ₹ 1,00,000/- and also observed that the relief already granted to the petitioner cannot be withdrawn merely on the objection raised by the opposite party, no further orders are required to be passed in the present petition. The same, is accordingly, disposed of.

The District Magistrate, Sonapat is, however, directed to give effect to the warrant of release dated 15.05.2015 within a
