By way of the instant writ petition, under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, the petitioners seek issuance of directions to the respondents to release the retiral benefits along with interest under regulations called Pepsu Road Transport Corporation Employees Pension/Gratuity and General Provident Fund Regulation, 1992.

At the very outset, the learned counsel for the petitioner states that the case of the petitioners is squarely covered by judgment of this Court in case **Ashok Kumar Vs. Pepsu Road Transport Corporation and others**, rendered in CWP No. 6971 of 2013, decided on 08.04.2015. The petitioner is similarly situated to the

petitioner as in CWP No. 6971 of 2013.

The learned counsel for the respondents does not controvert the assertion raised by learned counsel for the petitioners.

In view of the above position, the present petition is allowed. The respondent-Corporation is directed to release the entire retiral dues to the petitioners within a period of four months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

However, it is made clear that in case, the payment is not made within the stipulated period, the present petition shall be deemed to have been revived, without notice.
