Prayer has been made for release of the petitioner on parole so as to enable him to participate in the last rites of his grandmother, who died on 28.1.2015.

According to the petitioner, the last rites of his deceased grandmother are to be performed on 6.2.2015 i.e. today itself. On being asked by the Court, learned counsel for the petitioner has fairly conceded that though the petitioner's father is no more but his uncles are alive. Further, the petitioner has two other brothers. In such a situation, the uncles and brothers of the petitioner can very well conduct the necessary ceremonies by way of last rites of the grandmother of the petitioner.

In view of the above, no case is made out for the release of the petitioner on parole. The petition is, accordingly, dismissed.
