The instant petition has been filed under section 482 Cr.P.C seeking directions to the official respondents for grant of extension of the parole period beyond 15.11.2015.

The only ground and basis disclosed in the present petition is that wife of the petitioner is in an advanced stage of pregnancy and the expected date of delivery is in the 1st/2nd week of December, 2015.

Having argued the matter at some length counsel prays for withdrawal of the present petition with liberty that the petitioner after expiry of the current parole concession and after reporting back to the jail authorities would be entitled to submit an application afresh for parole on separate grounds and as may be permissible strictly in accordance with law.

Petition is dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty as prayed for.
