The present petition has been received by post. The allegations in the complaint are that wife of the petitioner, Manjit Kaur and his son Vikas Bedi, have been illegally detained by the police.

The learned State counsel submits that the petitioner is involved in four different FIRs registered against him for committing fraud with the different persons. The wife and son of the petitioner have been arrested in case FIR No. 56 dated 14.05.2014, registered under Sections 406 and 420 IPC, PS Jamalpur, Ludhiana.

As per the reply filed on behalf of the State, it is asserted that the petitioner, his wife and his son have been alleged to have committed a fraud of Rs.20 lacs with the complainant Rajesh Mehra by inducing him to give a role in Punjabi films and vide enquiry report dated 02.04.2014, an FIR No. 56 dated 14.05.2014, under Sections 406 and 420 IPC was registered against them.

In view of the above, the present petition stands dismissed.
