The interim bail is sought on the ground of marriage of son of the petitioner, named Sukhbir Singh. In response to the notice of motion order, inquiry was carried out by ASI Loveleen Kumar, I.O. Chowkidar, Police Station Sadar Nakodar and it transpired that Sukhbir Singh is not son of the petitioner rather he is son of brother-in-law of the petitioner. Therefore, no concession can be granted. Moreover the petitioner is involved in large number of FIRs under the NDPS Act.

Along with the petition, Annexure P-2, the certification by the Sarpanch has been enclosed that the son of the petitioner is getting married. The State is at liberty to take action against the Sarpanch for having issued certificate contrary to record.
