Petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Article 226 and 227 of the Constitution of India read with Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of direction in the nature of habeas Corpus for issuance directing the respondents to release the petitioner on emergency parole of eight weeks as his wife namely Bhan Kaur is seriously ill and in critical stage and under treatment in PGI, Chandigarh.

Learned counsel for the petitioner wants to withdraw this petition as his wife has died, with liberty to the petitioner to file fresh application to competent authority for grant of parole on the fresh ground regarding the death of his wife.

Dismissed as withdrawn. If the petitioner files any application to the competent authority then the same be decided expeditiously.
