JITENDRA CHAUHAN, J.

The petitioner has approached this Court under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, read with Section 3(1)(d) of the Haryana Good Conduct Prisoners (Temporary Release) Act, 1988, for grant of emergency parole for a period of four weeks.

Heard.

The parole is sought on the ground that the father of the petitioner is going to retire from government service and the retirement functions have been fixed from 29.12.2015 to 31.12.2015. The petitioner is a life convict in case FIR No.325 dated 20.10.1996 registered under Sections 302/34 of the Indian Penal Code. The ground on which the parole is sought does not appear to be a cogent ground.

In this view of the matter, this Court is no inclined to accept the prayer made in the present petition.

Dismissed.
