This Criminal Writ Petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of direction to respondent No.3 to grant parole for 48 hours to the petitioner to attend the marriage of his real brother on 02.01.2016.

In pursuance of order dated 19.12.2015, passed by this Court, the matter was inquired into and the learned State counsel, on instructions, states that the fact qua marriage of real brother of the petitioner fixed for 20.01.2016, is found to be correct.

Reply on behalf of respondents, filed in the Court, is taken on record.

Heard.

Considering the fact that the marriage of the real brother of the petitioner is fixed for 02.01.2016 and as per customs, he has to perform the rites and rituals, it is ordered that the petitioner will be taken to the venue of the marriage on the date fixed under the Police Protection. Accordingly, the authorities are directed to make the necessary arrangement for implementation of the order and all the expenses for the said purpose will be borne by the petitioner.

The petitioner shall be lodged in the jail on the same day.
