Petitioner has filed the instant petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ of Habeas Corpus for release of detinue Navjot Kaur, who is legally wedded wife of petitioner, from the illegal custody of respondent Nos.4 to 6 and to produce her in this Court.

Notice of motion was issued.

On the asking of the Court, Detinue Navjot Kaur, who is present in person before this Court, states that she wants to go with petitioner Manjinder Singh. She also states that she has already married with the petitioner but has not told this fact to her parents. She further states that now her parents have come to know regarding her marriage with the petitioner and they have no objection if she wants to go with the petitioner.

Learned counsel for respondent Nos.4 to 6 states that

respondent Nos.4 to 6 have no objection if she wants to go with the petitioner. He further states that now they have no connection or relation to continue with detainee Navjot Kaur.

In view of the statement of detainee Navjot Kaur, she is allowed to go with the petitioner.

Accordingly, the instant petition stands disposed of.
