On the asking of the Court, Mr. Deepak Sabherwal, Additional Advocate General, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondents. Let two copies of the writ petition be given to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

In this petition, the petitioner has prayed for extension of 30 days' parole which was stated to be granted by the Superintendent of District Jail, Bhondsi, District Gurgaon. The reason assigned for extension of parole is that his wife suffered heart attack. In order to get treatment to her, extension of parole is required. In support of the same, the petitioner has pleaded that

doctor has advised for admission of his wife on 31.12.2015 and the date of operation has been fixed on 1.1.2016. Since the earlier parole period expires on 31.12.2015, he has sought for extension by 30 days. In this regard, he has submitted an application for extension of parole to the Superintendent, District Jail, Bhondsi, District Gurgaon. The petitioner is stated to have been convicted for the offences under Sections 364-A/302/328/201/120-B IPC for a life term. The Superintendent of Jail, Bhondsi, District Gurgaon-respondent No.2 is directed to consider the application dated 20.12.2015 (P/4) sympathetically after perusal of the medical records and take a decision before 30.12.2015.

Disposed of accordingly.
