JITENDRA CHAUHAN, J.

The prayer in the present petition is for grant of parole to the petitioner under the Punjab Good Conduct Prisoners (Temporary Release) Amendment Act, 1962 on the ground that marriage of the petitioner's daughter has been fixed to be solemnized on 12.02.2015.

Notice of motion.

At the asking of the Court, Mr. Mehardeep Singh, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice. A complete copy of the paper book has been handed over to the learned State counsel, in the Court.

The learned State counsel, on telephonic instructions from HC Malkeet Singh, Pairvi Cell, Amritsar, admits the factum of the marriage of petitioner's daughter. He further informs that the petitioner never misused the concession of bail.

Heard.

Keeping in view the fact that the petitioner's daughter is getting married, the presence of the petitioner shall be required for ceremonial rituals as well as for making other arrangements required to be made in the marriage.

Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on emergency parole, for a period of three weeks from the date of his release, as per the Rules, on furnishing adequate surety bonds to the satisfaction of the District Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned.

The petitioner shall surrender before the jail authorities after expiry of three weeks, on the date and time to be indicated by the releasing Court.
