Status report by way of affidavit of Sh. Amarjit Singh, PPS, Superintendent of Police (Investigation), Ferozepur on behalf of the State, has been filed and the same is taken on record.

It is stated on behalf of the State that Meera Rani has been recovered from the custody of Sukhdev Singh. Accused Sukhdev Singh has been arrested and challan against him has been presented. Initially, Meera Rani was sent to Nari Niketan but later on, in her statement recorded under Section 164 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, before the learned Sub Divisional Judicial

Magistrate, Guruharsahai, she opted not to accompany her parents. But later on, she was again produced in the Court and recorded her statement that she wants to join the company of her parents. Today her parents are also present along with Meera Rani.

Since Meera Rani has been recovered, this petition has become infructuous and is disposed of as such.
