MAHESH GROVER, J (ORAL)

This is a petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of habeas corpus for release of the alleged detenues, mentioned in para 3 of the petition, who are not being given salary and are stated to be in the illegal detention of respondents no.4 to 6.

While issuing notice of motion on 10.02.2015, this Court directed respondent no.2 to depute any officer to ascertain the factum of the detenues being in illegal custody and without salary by respondent no.4. A status report was also sought.

As per short reply filed today, Naib Tehsildar, Dera Bassi along with Labour Inspector Sh.Mukhtiar Singh visited the spot and recorded statements of 22 labourers present there along with their children, who stated that they had come on brick kiln at their own sweet will and no money is due to the brick kiln owner . However, these persons were sent

along with two Constables.

In view of the reply, when no person was found in illegal custody of respondents no.4 to 6, no further order is required to be passed in the present case and the same stands disposed of accordingly.
