Prayer in this petition filed under Article 226 of Constitution of India, is for issuance of a writ in the nature of Habeas Corpus.

In compliance of the order dated 11.02.2015, Mr. K.S. Pannu, DAG, Punjab has put in appearance for respondents no.1 to 3 and Mr. Vipin Mahajan, Advocate has appeared for respondents no.4 to 7. The alleged detainee, Rishu Bala is also present in Court. She (Rishu Bala) has discussed the matter with Ms. Rachna Rudra, Advocate and thereafter, stated at bar that she wanted to live with petitioner with whom she had solemnized the marriage. She has further stated that she is more than 20 years

of age and a student of B.A. IInd year.

In view of the above, after taking instructions from Ramesh Kumar respondent No.4, Mr. Vipin Mahajan, Advocate submits that he has no objection if the alleged detenue wants to reside with the petitioner.

In view of the statement suffered by the counsel for the private respondents, the petitioner does not press this petition at this stage.

Disposed of accordingly.
