

MANJIT KAUR VS STATE OF PUNJAB

Mr. Jasdeep Singh, PPS, Senior Superintendent of Police, Amritsar (Rural) is present in Court and has expressed his regret at not having filed his personal affidavit. Further, with regard to the reply filed on the last date, he has explained that the copy of the petition had inadvertently been sent to the office of the Commissioner of Police, Amritsar and was received only on 24.02.2015 but on the basis of the information which had been received the reply has been filed. His explanation is accepted.

As per reply, he has filed his personal affidavit, as per which it has been stated that as regards the elder son of the petitioner i.e. Gurjant Singh, an FIR had been lodged regarding the stealing of a motorcycle. Subsequently, a secret informer had informed that the said motorcycle was in the possession of said Gurjant Singh and that he was coming from his village Kotli Kortana to Amritsar and a Nakka was laid and Gurjant Singh the son of the petitioner was found coming, when he was signalled to stop, but he did not stop the motorcycle and ran away abandoning the same and was never arrested and in fact efforts are still on to arrest him. With regard to the allegation about the second son that Vijay Shamsheer, it has also been clarified that he was never arrested nor he had any case pending against him. He further says that the said Gurjant Singh is till today evading arrest.

In the circumstances, the present petition is dismissed.
