REKHA MITTAL, J.(ORAL)

The petitioner has filed the instant petition under Article 227 of the Constitution of India for grant of emergency parole to the petitioner under Section 3 & 4 of the Punjab Good Conduct Prisoners (Temporary Release) Act, 1962 for a period of 4 weeks on account of illness of his mother.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that unfortunately the mother of the petitioner has passed away on 18.02.2015 and the petitioner has been allowed to attend her cremation at Delhi in custody. It is further submitted that the petitioner may be allowed parole for a period of 2 weeks to enable him to be by the side of his family during this hour of grief and attend the rituals and ceremonies in connection with last rites.

The matter with regard to grant of parole is it within the domain of jail authorities, therefore, the petition stands disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to file an appropriate application before the Superintendent, Central Jail, Patiala and in case such application is filed by the petitioner, the same shall be disposed of by the said authority within three days from the date of its filing.
