Feeling aggrieved against the alleged inaction on the part of respondent authorities, petitioner has approached this Court by way of instant criminal writ petition, seeking appropriate directions against the respondent authorities to consider and decide the application of the petitioner.

Notice of motion was issued and pursuant thereto, reply by way of affidavit dated 27.03.2015 was filed.

Learned counsel for the State, while referring to the averments taken in the reply and particularly in para 3 of preliminary objections, submits that since no such application has been received from the petitioner, no action was taken in this regard. He further submits that let the petitioner be directed to move an appropriate representation/application to the competent authority and the same shall be considered and decided, in accordance with law.

Faced with the above, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner may be granted liberty to move the appropriate application and he will do the needful within three weeks from today.

In view of the above respective stands taken by learned counsel for the parties, present petition is disposed of, with liberty to the petitioner to move an appropriate representation/application to the competent authority within a period of three weeks from today. On doing the needful by the petitioner within three weeks, competent authority shall consider the application of the petitioner at an early date, by passing an appropriate order thereon, strictly in accordance with law and in any case, within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of such an application on behalf of the petitioner.

With the abovesaid observations made and directions issued, present petition stands disposed of.
