This petition has been filed for extension of parole to the petitioner, which has already been granted to him by respondent No.2 for a period of four weeks i.e up to 20.02.2015.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the father of the petitioner is having heart problem and hence, the operation has been suggested by the doctor to him.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has not been able to place on record the document to show that a specific date has been given for operation to the father of the petitioner or he has been advised operation by the doctor. The parole period granted to the petitioner has expired today.

No ground is made out to extend period of parole to the petitioner at this stage.

The petition is accordingly dismissed.

However, the petitioner is directed to surrender before the concerned jail authorities today itself and in case, the operation is advised by the doctor to father of the petitioner and specific date for this purpose is given, the petitioner is at liberty to move fresh application for grant of parole.
