The instant petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of Habeas Corpus for the release of detainee mentioned in para No.2 of the writ petition who are stated to be in illegal, unlawful custody of respondents No.4 and 5.

Reply filed by way of an affidavit of Kala Ram Kansal, Sub Divisional Magistrate, Lehra, District Sangrur in Court today is taken on record subject to all just exceptions.
