A complaint dated 12.2.2015 made by Smt. Rajinder Kaur was received by post in the Registry and was treated as the instant criminal writ petition.

As per complaint, allegations were that son of the complainant namely, Randeep Singh, who was working in a factory as a daily wage labourer has been picked up by police party on 27.1.2015 and has been detained thereafter unlawfully.

As per reply, filed on behalf of the State, a stand was taken that the alleged detainee namely, Randeep Singh had never been picked up by the police of CIA Staff Commissionerate of Police Jalandhar. On the last date of hearing i.e. 27.4.2015, the learned State counsel was directed to complete instructions with regard to ascertaining the whereabouts of the alleged detainee.

During the course of hearing today, learned State counsel upon instructions from ASI Mohan Singh, CIA Staff, Jalandhar has apprised the Court that Randeep Singh son of late Balwinder Singh has been arrested during the course of investigation pertaining to FIR No.5 dated 21.01.2015, under Sections 302,379-B,353,427,186,148,149 IPC registered at Police Station Sadar Phagwara and is presently lodged in Central Jail, Kapurthala.

In the light of such factual information apprised by the learned State counsel, no directions are required to be passed in the instant petition and the same is accordingly, disposed of.
