ASI Bikar Singh from police station Chola Sahib is present who had been deputed to make the enquiry as is also written in the reply filed by the respondent-State. He submits that he had gone to see the house of the petitioner and found that it was in bad condition and needed immediate repair. It is mentioned in the reply that no-one is ready to take responsibility of the petitioner. That part would be immaterial because no-one is able to take such a responsibility as it may entail certain consequences.

In view of the submission made by ASI Bikar Singh, the request of the petitioner is allowed and he is ordered to be released on parole for a period of four weeks on his furnishing bail bonds to the satisfaction of Superintendent, Central Jail, Amritsar.
