Petitioner has preferred this writ petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India to extend the parole by 4 weeks to perform last rites of his father, who died on 13.02.2015.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has stated that petitioner Robin has already surrendered before the jail authorities on 19.02.2015.

Heard.

No ground to extend the parole is made out as the petitioner has already surrendered before the jail authorities. Therefore, the instant petition has become infructuous and is dismissed as such. However, the petitioner is at liberty to apply before the competent authority for further parole.
