This is a petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying for release of petitioner on emergency parole for two weeks in a case registered against him vide FIR No.259 dated 03.11.2011 under Section 22 of NDPS Act, 1985.

Learned State counsel, at the outset, submits that case of the petitioner is not covered under Punjab Good Conduct Prisoners (Temporary Release) Act, 1962 (for short 'the Act'). According to him, parole can be granted only in such cases where Section 3 of the Act is attracted.

Under the circumstances, I am of the considered view that petition preferred by the petitioner is misconceived. Same is hereby dismissed. Petitioner shall, however, be at liberty to avail alternative remedy, if any, available to him.
