Learned counsel for the State, while referring to the report dated 19.01.2015 of SHO/Inspector Jasbir Singh, Police Station Beri District Jhajjar, submits that since the alleged detainees have already been released, the present writ petition has been rendered infructuous.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that since the luggage of the petitioner and detainees as well as their salary have not been released by respondents No.5 to 7, they may be directed to release the same in favour of the petitioner and detainees

Having heard the learned counsel for the parties and after careful perusal of the record of the case, the present writ petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner and other alleged detainees to pursue their other remedies in accordance with the law, for getting their alleged luggage (s) and salary released. It is so said because writ jurisdiction of this Court cannot be invoked in the matters involving seriously disputed question of facts, as the alleged amount of salary etc. is not an admitted one.

In view of the above, present petition is disposed of, with aforesaid liberty.
