This Criminal Writ Petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of direction to the respondents to add the period of remissions granted to the convict upto the period 11.09.2001 in terms of orders dated 10.08.2011 (Annexure P-2), dated 25.01.2013 (Annexure P-3) and dated 08.04.2013 (Annexure P-4) passed by this Court.

The learned counsel for the petitioner states that at this stage he would be satisfied in case directions are issued to respondent No.2 to consider and decide the case of the petitioner in terms of orders (Annexures P-2 to P-4) passed by this Court.

The learned State counsel has no objection to the proposal of the learned counsel for the petitioner.

In view of the consensus arrived at between the parties, without adverting to the merits of the case, at this stage, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2, to treat the present petition as representation of the petitioner and on submission of such representation within two weeks from the receipt of a certified copy of this order, the same shall be decided in the light of orders dated 10.08.2011 (Annexure P-2), dated 25.01.2013 (Annexure P-3) and dated 08.04.2013 (Annexure P-4) passed by this Court, by passing a speaking order, within a period of 2 weeks thereafter.
