Application is allowed and Annexures P-5 and P-6 are taken on record.

Main case

This petition has been filed under Article 226//227 of the Constitution of India read with Section 482 Cr.P.C. for grant of emergency parole to the petitioner in case FIR No.22 dated 15.02.2008 under Section 420 IPC on medical grounds.

In pursuance of the notice of motion, medical status report was filed by way of short affidavit prepared by Superintendent, Central Jail, Amritsar. As per this status report, the petitioner, on account of ailment, is bed ridden and cannot look after himself. He is catheterised and the catheter has to be changed after 10-15 days. It has been advised by the doctor that it

would be better if he is taken care by the family members.

Considering the medical history of the petitioner and the report of treating doctor, the petitioner is ordered to be released on parole, for a period of six weeks from the date of his release, as per the Rules, on furnishing bonds to the satisfaction of the District Magistrate concerned.

The petitioner shall surrender before the jail authorities after expiry of six weeks, on the date and time to be indicated by the releasing authority at the time of his release.
