Short reply by way of an affidavit dated 18.03.2015 filed in Court today, is taken on record and a copy thereof has been supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the State fairly submits that let the District Magistrate, Jalandhar-respondent No.3 be directed to consider the request of the petitioner.

Faced with the above, learned counsel for the petitioner also submits that liberty may be granted to the petitioner to represent to the District Magistrate, Jalandhar, who, in turn, be directed to consider and decide the same in a time bound manner.

In view of the above stand taken by the parties, this petition is disposed of with a direction that if the petitioner approaches the District Magistrate, Jalandhar-respondent No.3 by moving an appropriate representation within a period of 5 days from today, he shall consider and decide the same by passing a speaking order before 25.03.2015.
