During the course of arguments learned counsel for the petitioner seeks indulgence of this Court to replace relief clause from emergency parole to interim bail on account of marriage of his daughter Amandeep Kaur. Vide order dated 09.03.2015, notice of motion was issued for today and the factum of marriage was ordered to be verified by the State of Punjab.

Mr. Arsheep Singh Kler, D.A.G., Punjab on instructions from ASI Gurnaam Singh has confirmed the date of marriage of the daughter of the petitioner, scheduled to be solemnized on

13.03.2015.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner would be satisfied in case he is allowed to attend the marriage ceremony of his daughter in police custody.

Superintendent Central Jail, Amritsar is directed to depute requisite police force to take the petitioner to the place of marriage and allow the petitioner to attend the marriage without any hinderance but reasonable restrain should be observed so as to prevent him fleeing from custody.

Superintendent Central Jail, Amritsar is directed to ensure that the petitioner will return to the jail premises in the evening of 13.03.2015 at about 7.00 P.M. It would be the subjective satisfaction of the jail Superintendent to depute as many as policemen for ensuring that there may not be any untoward incident.

Petition disposed of accordingly.
