Instant petition has been filed under Article 226 of Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of Habeas Corpus directing respondent No.2 to get release the detainee mentioned in para No.3 of the petition from the illegal custody of respondents No.4 and 5.

Vide order dated March 04, 2015, notice of motion was issued for March 19, 2015 and in the meantime, registry was directed to appoint a Warrant Officer, it being a Habeas Corpus petition. But after issuance of notice neither process fee was filed nor petitioner turned up to take Warrant Officer to the places to be pointed out by the petitioner to find out the alleged detainee.

Even, on March 24, 2015, none appeared on behalf of petitioner and in the interest of justice, matter was adjourned for today i.e. March 30, 2015.

Today, again neither petitioner nor her counsel has put in

appearance, despite several calls. It appears that petitioner does not want to pursue with instant petition.

Accordingly, instant petition is dismissed.
