**RAJ MOHAN SINGH, J.**

Prayer in this petition is for grant of parole in order to enable the petitioner to attend marriage of his daughter, which is scheduled to be solemnized on 29/30.04.2015. On 17.03.2015, this Court passed the following order:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that marriage of the daughter of the petitioner namely Priya @ Khushbu is fixed for 29.04.2015. On earlier occasion petitioner ventured to file CrI.W.P. No.251 of 2015 which was disposed of vide order dated 24.02.2015 with liberty to the petitioner to move an application before the Superintendent Jail concerned who was obligated to decide the representation within one week on receipt thereof.

Now the said representation has been declined by the Superintendent, District Jail, Karnal by referring to Section 4(1) of the Haryana Government, Jails Department Notification No.S.O121/H.A..28/19888/S 10/2007 to say that parole can only be granted after completion of one year of imprisonment of the convict and in case convict earns his first annual good conduct remission under the Act.

Since the marriage of the daughter is fixed for 29.04.2015 let notice of motion of this petition be issued to respondents for 21.04.2015.”

In order to comply with the aforesaid order, police party went to Bihar in order to ascertain the factum of marriage. Now on verification, it has been found that the marriage of daughter of the petitioner is fixed for 29.04.2015. The report of DSP duly accompanied by certificate issued by the Gram Panchayat are the evidence to this effect.

Petitioner is directed to execute necessary security in a sum of Rs.1,00,000/- to the satisfaction of the Superintendent Jail, Karnal.

In view of aforesaid, Superintendent Jail, Karnal as well as the Superintendent of Police, Panipat are directed to depute necessary policemen to take the petitioner to Bihar in order to facilitate him to attend marriage of his daughter on 29<sup>th</sup> and 30<sup>th</sup> of April, 2015. Superintendent of Police, Panipat is directed to ensure adequate security measures from S.P. Champaran (Bihar) before the release of the petitioner from jail. Accused shall be brought back by the police after completion of necessary ceremonies to the jail premises forthwith.

In the aforesaid context, the police may seek further police help from concerned police Station in Bihar, if need be.
