JASPAL SINGH, J.

This petition has been preferred under Article 226 of the Constitution of India read with Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking extension of furlough/parole already granted to Paramjit Singh-petitioner under Section 3(1)(a) of the Punjab Good Conduct Prisoners (Temporary Release) Act, 1962 for one month on the ground that petitioner is suffering from ISCHAEMIC HEART DISEASE & UNSTABLE ANGINA.

2. The contention of learned counsel for petitioner is that petitioner is a life convict and serving his sentence of imprisonment in Modern Jail, Jalandhar at Kapurthala. At the time of presentation of petition, he was on furlough for 14 days from February 28, 2015 to

March 14, 2015 and he was to surrender back in Jail on March 14, 2015. Considering the fact of serious illness of petitioner, notice of motion was issued and furlough/parole already being availed was extended from time to time.

3. Today, learned State counsel has furnished a letter issued by Dr. JS Mann, Managing Director, Mann Medlciti Super Speciality Hospital stating that certificate dated March 09, 2015 was issued by him and same is genuine. Patient-petitioner is under treatment in his hospital, which is likely to continue. Certificate placed on record has been found to be genuine, according to which petitioner is suffering from ISCHAEMIC HEART DISEASE & UNSTABLE ANGINA, which requires to undergo coronary angiography. Since, petitioner is already on parole and petitioner requires constant medical treatment and supervision, which would not be available with jail authorities, petitioner is allowed to continue to remain on emergency parole for a period of one month from today, in order to continue his treatment in Mann Medlciti Super Specialty Hospital or any other hospital of his choice. However, it is made clear that after expiry of aforesaid period of one month, petitioner is directed to surrender before Superintendent Jail, Jalandhar at Kapurthala.

4. Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
